I OPPOSE [HB 3403].

From the TEXT of [HB 3403], "... SECTION 1. The Department of Education shall study the adequacy of education in the public schools of this state. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to education no later than September 15, 2026. SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027."

[SB HB 3403] requires a professional report using significant resources defined in [ORS 192.245].
