



Transportation Services for Tribal Members

More than 700 tribal members and their spouses received transportation service last year to see doctors, get to work or visit colleges


The Coquille Indian Tribe (CIT) has more than 1,100 members, over half of whom reside in the Tribe's five-county service area of Coos, Lane, Curry, Jackson and Douglas counties. The Tribe has jurisdiction over 6,422 acres of trust lands located in Coos County.

The Empire Reservation between Empire and Charleston is the site of Kilkich, a community that is home to more than 220 people. Additional Coquille Tribal Lands include non-contiguous trust land in southeastern Coos County and fee land in Medford.

Coquille Indian Tribal transportation is provided by staff from the Ko-Kwel Wellness Center and CIT's Culture, Education and Learning Services (CELS) Department. The mission is to assist Tribal members and spouses both inside and outside the Tribe's five-county service area.

Transportation services are provided to elders, youth and disabled individuals. Transportation service meets the need for health, education, work and social/recreational purposes.

There is also travel reimbursement for medical, dental, mental health or addiction treatment services, as well as for community service case plans to assist individuals become self-sufficient.
