I find it hard to understand how our state government can put forth such a large increase in taxes and fees for operating a vehicle. How is it that many other states are able to have significantly lower gas taxes and gas prices in general and yet are able to handle more and better road maintenance than Oregon. Taking Wisconsin for example is charging \$2.59/gallon for regular unleaded gasoline, more than a dollar less than here in McMinnville, yet has much more snow removal and road maintenance costs than Oregon.
