I employ through various businesses over 65 employees. Most of these employees commute to work since two our locations are in two smaller towns that can't support the required employees need to run our family operated businesses. We have had to increase our wages so dramatically over the last 4 years due to the cost of living, much of which is a result of some of the highest minimum wage requirements here in the state, but also with the inflation that has plagued our nation over the last 3 years. Adding a gas tax to Oregonians budgets is not something that most people can afford given the economic pressures that we have all been feeling for food, rent and what we currently pay at the gas pump already. How are people going to save for a home or for their children's education or even maintain a current lifestyle they see waning already.
