Every day, I have to walk or bike along unsafe roads to get to where I want or need to go. We've had too many close calls, and my wife no longer feels safe riding a bicycle in town, forcing her to use a car, which is much more resource-intensive and often less pleasant, when she otherwise would not.

The Safe Routes to School and Great Streets programs will make our streets safer for everyone, especially kids, elders, and people who don't drive.

Finally, while I fully support on-street safety investments, they often lead nowhere if we don't also fund off-street connections. That is why I urge you to include funding for the Oregon Community Paths program to create a complete and connected network. I urge you to support HB 2025 and fully fund these life-saving programs.
