SB243

I oppose SB 243 for the following reasons. First, in June 2024 the Supreme Court struck down a federal ban stating a firearm with a bump stock do not qualify as a machine gun. By passing this bill the Oregon Legislature will be impeding the 2nd Amendment rights for US citizens living in Oregon. This is not a vote by the people. It is Oregon's Legislature imposing their will on the state of Oregon again. Secondly, by imposing a 72 hour wait period on sales or transfer of a firearm goes against a US Citizens Right to Bear Arms, by delaying that right by 3 days at minimum.
