This bill originally began as a "study," but it has since been amended to include provisions that impose unconstitutional restrictions, raise age limits, and add new limitations on lands adjacent to certain public areas. It is deeply concerning that legislators—such as Senator Floyd Prozanski—would support the submission of an amendment that undermines the Second Amendment rights of all Oregonians.

The practice of "gut and stuff"—where legislation is introduced under one premise and later replaced with entirely different content—is a deliberate tactic used to obscure true intentions and limit public scrutiny. Such actions are irresponsible and should not be used to erode constitutional rights.

I sincerely hope these tactics are brought to light during the next election cycle, and that voters hold Senator Prozanski accountable for supporting this approach.

I strongly oppose this bill, and I strongly oppose the procedural manipulation that appears designed to suppress public input on a matter of such significance.
