I also urge you to strengthen the package's climate and equity impact by:

Including robust funding for electrification programs and community charging infrastructure;

Supporting a Luxury Vehicle Privilege Tax to ensure progressive, fair funding mechanisms;

And maintaining strong oversight and accountability for ODOT to prevent ballooning megaproject budgets and ensure funds are used for community-centered priorities.

Let's build a transportation system where every Oregonian can thrive. Please support HB 2025 with full funding for safety, active transportation, public transit, and climate-forward solutions—and say no to wasteful highway expansions.
