In the current year, the insurance expenses of the organization went over the roof, with the previous insurer dropping us without any explanation.

It is my belief that recent frivolous lawsuits against recreation organizations and Oregon towns (who might have thought that one can slip on a wet trail?!), and court decisions nullified enforceability of liability waivers, driving the insurance costs up. This drives recreation organizations out of business, and disproportionately affects local businesses, outfitters, guides, non-profits, and other smaller organizations with limited means.

I urge you to vote this bill into a law.
