For the record, my name is Ryan Hite. I am writing to express my strong opposition to HB 2025.

To do our jobs safely and effectively as a forest operator in Oregon, we depend on a network of safe, well-maintained roads. As contributors to the transportation system, our members are also key payers into the system.

We urge you to give serious consideration to the significant tax increases proposed in this package. These increases would place additional financial strain on the commercial trucking industry, which is already facing considerable challenges.

We are also concerned that this bill lacks meaningful accountability measures for the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) and fails to adequately prioritize investment in core transportation infrastructure. We need legislation that grows commerce, population and transportation capacity.

We support finding solutions together with the Legislature which would be fair and sustainable for growing all-Oregon businesses, workers, trucking, ports, and a safe transportation system.
