Please preserve what my Grandfather fought for in WWII!

I understand those who oppose this bill claim some example incidents as reasons for opposing this bill. Some state that passing the bill would make it much harder to hold entities liable, pointing out it would be difficult to prove the level of negligence. It should be a high bar to prove anyone guilty of something. Are you telling me it's more important to make a lawyer's job easier than it is to ensure broad & continued access to outdoor activities? If we make new rules every time something bad happens, we are going to end up with a state/world that has nothing left to offer due to all the restrictions.
