I OPPOSE [HB 3390 A].

From the TEXT of [HB 3390 A], "... SECTION 4. Notwithstanding ORS 250.085: (1) Any elector dissatisfied with the ballot title for a measure described in section 1 of this 2025 Act prepared by the joint legislative committee appointed under section 6 of this 2025 Act may petition the Supreme Court seeking a different ballot title."

"...SECTION 5. Notwithstanding ORS 251.235: (1) Any person dissatisfied with the explanatory statement for a measure described in section 1 of this 2025 Act prepared by the joint legislative committee appointed under section 6 of this 2025 Act may petition the Supreme Court seeking a different explanatory statement and stating the reasons the explanatory statement filed with the court is insufficient or unclear..."

[HB 3390 A] permits 'Third parties' to review and possibly rewrite 'Ballot Titles and Statements' and these actions I will not abide.
