Chair Bowman, Vice-Chair Drazan, Vice-Chair Pham, and Members of the House Committee on Rules:

**The Consolidated Oregon Indivisible Network (COIN) strongly opposes HB 3392 and urges you to reject this secretive and last-minute effort to delay the campaign finance law (HB 4024) which many grassroots groups advocated for during the 2024 legislative session.**

We join with the testimony of Honest Elections Oregon in its entirety in urging you to oppose any changes to HB 4024 that impair its campaign contribution limits, disclosure requirements, or enforcement provisions. We also oppose any further delay in implementation.

COIN is a coalition of more than 50 local Indivisible groups, made up of more than 30,000 individuals throughout Oregon that cooperate and amplify their joint efforts to, among other things, defend our democracy. We believe strong campaign finance reform, sooner rather than later, is essential to this mission.
