I am proud to be living in our incredible state, with its diverse array of flora and fauna, and habitats that support them. Unfortunately, a variety of impacts, including biological invasions, climate change, and habitat conversion, put their future at risk. Already almost 300 of our species are categorized as having greatest conservation need and 11 of our habitats are categorized as 'conservation concern'. Oregon's organisms and habitats are fundamental to many Oregon industries and the health and well-being of us Oregonians.

To ensure all species and habitats thrive in Oregon – we need bold, proactive investments in their recovery. The bill also allocates funds for wildlife stewardship, Oregon Conservation and Recreation Fund, anti-poaching efforts, wildlife connectivity and invasive species control – which further bolster wildlife conservation in the state. HB 2977 provides a steady, sustainable source of funds to the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to recover Oregon's most imperiled species and habitat and enhance biodiversity – all of which contribute to Oregon's tourism and outdoor recreation economy.
