Water League supports HB 2977 A, which imposes a 1.25% increase to Oregon's state transient lodging tax not only because Oregon's tourism industry generates billions in economic activity annually, in part due to healthy ecosystems, but also because we support public policies that use transient lodging taxes to augment other funding that protects and conserves Oregon's wildlife and the precious natural resources they rely upon to thrive.
