While I understand and appreciate Secretary of State Tobias Read's plea for more time to implement campaign finance limits passed in 2024, I do not believe that a FOUR YEAR delay is warranted. As it is, many of the most technical and complicated aspects of the law won't need to be implemented for another 2 or 3 years. And frankly, I'd rather have a less than perfectly implemented campaign finance law than none at all. In my view, HB3392 seems more designed to make the whole thing go away than to actually fix things, and the fact that this was slipped in a couple of days before the end of the session would be consistent with that view. Oregon is one of FIVE states without campaign limits, and that seems terribly embarrassing. Please do not pass HB 3392.
