HB2977

HB 2977 passed in the Oregon House with strong bipartisan support. This bill would provide critical, long-overdue funding for protecting Oregon's native wildlife, restoring habitats, reducing wildlife-vehicle collisions, and supporting efforts to help people and wildlife coexist. HB 2977 proposes a modest funding solution: raising the statewide lodging tax by just 1.25 percent. Oregon's lodging tax is currently one of the lowest in the country. That's just \$1.25 per \$100—what Republican co-sponsor Representative Mark Owens called “less than a cup of coffee.”
