I strongly oppose House Bill 2025 due to its unprecedented tax and fee increases, projected to cost Oregon households over \$1,140 annually by 2034. This \$14.6 billion package, including a 15-cent gas tax hike, new vehicle sales taxes, and per-mile fees for electric and hybrid vehicles, places an undue burden on working families during a cost-of-living crisis. The secretive process behind this bill and its dismissal of public input undermine transparency and trust. Oregonians deserve affordable solutions for transportation infrastructure, not massive tax hikes that threaten our economy and drive businesses away. I urge you to vote NO on HB 2025 and prioritize fiscally responsible alternatives.
