We urge you to oppose HB 3402-03. This measure only provides for ODOT and ODOT jobs when every transportation system in the state is in crisis and need of support.

Please reject this measure and work on a resolution to HB 2025, which doesn't leave cities and counties behind. It is critical that all transportation systems in the state receive funding and support.

PBOT frontline workers are the backbone of the transportation system in Portland and we cannot accept a transportation measure that does not recognize the crucial role that workers hold in keeping the city moving.

Transportation workers across the state provide the necessary maintenance and repairs so that we can get to work, school, and home safely. Please pass a transportation package that respects workers across the state, and throughout all of Oregon's cities and counties.

If emergency sessions are required that extend the date of this legislative season then I believe that's worth saving not only dozens of jobs in Portland but most likely hundreds more across the state
