## **OREGON RETIREMENT SAVINGS BOARD**

The Governor has appointed the following individual to the Oregon Retirement Savings Board subject to Senate confirmation.<sup>1</sup>

### Re-appointee

Kara Backus of Portland

#### **Term**

September 1, 2025 – August 31, 2029

#### **Appointment/Confirmation Authority**

ORS 178.200 (2023)

### Statement of Economic Interest<sup>2</sup>

Not required.

### Composition<sup>3</sup>

The board consist of seven members, four of whom are appointed by the Governor, including:

- a representative of employers (BACKUS);
- a representative with investments experience (GONZALEZ);
- a representative of an association representing employees (J. ANDERSON);
- a retired public member (DEMONNIN);
- the State Treasurer or the designee (STEINER);
- a senator, appointed by the President of the Senate, nonvoting and advisory (D. ANDERSON); and
- a representative appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, nonvoting and advisory (D. NGUYEN).

Gubernatorial appointees serve four-year terms and are eligible for reappointment. The State Treasurer or designee serves as chair. A majority of the voting members constitutes a quorum.

#### **Duties**<sup>4</sup>

The board establishes, oversees, and has general fiduciary responsibility for a state-run retirement savings program. The board must:

- develop a defined contribution retirement plan;
- not guarantee any rate of return or any interest rate on any contribution;
- adopt rules for administration of the plan;
- report each calendar year to the Governor and to the Legislative Assembly detailing the board's activities; and
- administer the Oregon Retirement Savings Plan Administrative Fund.
