OREGON TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION

The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the Oregon Transportation Commission subject to Senate confirmation.¹

Statement of Economic Interest²

Required.

Composition³

The commission consists of five members (**BAKER (R), BEYER (D)**, BROWN (R), CHAPMAN (D), CHANG (D)).

One member must be a resident of the area east of the Cascade Range (CHANG). Not more than three members may belong to one political party. Members serve four-year terms. The Governor appoints one of the members as chair, who appoints the vice chair. A majority of the members constitutes a quorum. The commission must meet at least quarterly.

Duties⁴

The commission establishes state transportation policy and guides the planning, development, and management of a statewide transportation network. The commission must:

- appoint a Director of Transportation to supervise the Department of Transportation (ODOT), who is subject to confirmation by the Senate;
- establish the policies for ODOT's operation;
- develop and maintain state transportation policies and a 20-year long-range plan;
- develop plans for each mode of transportation;
- initiate studies to guide the director concerning transportation needs;
- prescribe the administrative practices followed by the director;
- enter into intergovernmental agreements with local governments and local service districts to encourage cooperation and maximize the efficiency;
- review and approve ODOT's proposed transportation projects, budget, anticipated capital construction requirements, construction priorities, and selection, vacation, or abandonment of state highways;
- adopt a statewide transportation strategy on greenhouse gas emissions;
- adopt necessary rules and orders;
- review and update the criteria used to select projects within the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program;
- compile an inventory of real property owned by ODOT;
- approve the appointment of a chief engineer;
- report to the Governor on legislative, budgetary, and administrative programs;
- designate an ODOT internal auditor and report on audits to the Joint Legislative Audit Committee;
- develop standards for the consistent description and reporting of the condition of transportation infrastructure owned by the state, counties, and cities;
- develop a website with information about projects in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program;
- appoint specified advisory committees to advise the commission on its work;
- distribute moneys in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Fund; and
- provide two members to serve on the Road User Fee Task Force.
