### STATE LIBRARY BOARD

The Governor has appointed the following individual to the State Library Board subject to Senate confirmation.<sup>1</sup>

# Statutory Requirements<sup>3</sup>

The board consists of 10 members, including:

- two individuals from two different state agencies (TATE, WEERAWARDENA);
- one public library representative from eastern Oregon (ESTRADA);
- one public library representative from western Oregon (WILLIAMS);
- one public member from eastern Oregon (MALKIN);
- one public member from western Oregon (PERKINS);
- one community college or public university library representative (DEITERING);
- the Deputy Superintendent of Public Instruction or designee (ROBERTS);
- the administrator of the Commission for the Blind (PORTILLO); and
- the State Librarian, ex officio, nonvoting (CORNELISEN).

Gubernatorial appointees serve four-year terms. The board selects its chair and vice chair. The board shall meet at least once every three months.

#### **Duties**<sup>4</sup>

The board is the policy-making body for the State Library. The board must:

- formulate general policies adopt rules;
- adopt long-range strategic plans and develop key performance measures;
- review and approve budget requests that align with the board's long-range plans;
- develop, adopt, and modify a technology plan for the purchase of subscriptions statewide, for reference-based databases, digitization of records for public libraries, and integration of services provided by the State Library;
- conduct certifications of state agency libraries or library services;
- review and monitor the State Library and its work in the State Reference Coordinating Council;
- administer the State Library Donation Fund for the benefit of the State Library;
- report to the Legislative Assembly in January of each odd-numbered year on the State Library's efforts to achieve its statutory mission;
- designate no more than 10 libraries as depository libraries, which shall be entitled to receive copies of government publications;
- administer assessments against state agencies for operating costs of the State Library and financial assistance grants to public, school, tribal, and academic libraries;
- establish minimum conditions for public; and
- administer financial assistance for public library services to children.
