PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 902

In line 2 of the printed bill, before the period insert "creating new provisions; and amending ORS 238A.160".

"SECTION 1. ORS 238A.160, as amended by section 4, chapter 101,
Oregon Laws 2024, is amended to read:

"238A.160. (1) Except as provided in subsections (2) and (3) of this section,
normal retirement age for a member of the pension program is the earlier
of:

9 "(a) 65 years of age; or
