HB 4028 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/3/2026 MEETING: Imposes requirements and restrictions on insurer and coordinated care organization audits of claims for reimbursement submitted by behavioral health treatment providers.

HB 4070

Provides that a community mental health program is not responsible for the cost of emergency psychiatric care, custody and treatment when state funds provided to the community mental health program are exhausted.

#### Work Session

HB 4083

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to, no later than June 30, 2027, adopt a uniform process for credentialing organizational behavioral health providers and establish a centralized portal for processing applications.

HB 4068

Modifies the definition of "transition aged youth residential treatment home" to include young adults between the ages of 17 and 25.
