HB 4039 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to develop a transparent and data-driven process for developing capitation rates for coordinated care organizations.

HB 4127

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to adopt a payment mechanism to pay certain nonprofit reproductive health care providers that are not eligible to receive federal Medicaid funds for services provided to medical assistance recipients.

#### Public Hearing

***The following bill is scheduled solely for the purpose of taking public testimony on the proposed - 27 amendments. Amendments will be made available on OLIS as soon as possible.***

HB 4040

Modifies the requirements for screening a hospital patient for presumptive eligibility for financial assistance.

HB 4038

Prohibits the Oregon Health Authority from taking enforcement actions against providers or payers under the Health Care Cost Growth Target program before January 1, 2036.

HB 4119

Requires for the certification of a managed care provider plan that the plan not discriminate against any willing provider within the geographical service area of the managed care organization.

HB 4142

Expands the definition of "debilitating medical condition" for the medical use of marijuana.

HB 4155 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires certain health insurers, the Oregon Educators Benefit Board and the Public Employees' Benefit Board to cover fertility services and treatments.

HB 4053 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes the Emergency Medical Services Program Fund.

HB 4074

Directs a hospital to implement a hospital-wide nurse staffing plan that has been developed and adopted by the hospital nurse staffing committee or, if the committee has not adopted a plan, a hospital-wide nurse staffing plan that meets the statutory requirements.
