Public Hearing

HB 4135

Designates March 4th of each year as HPV Awareness Day.

HB 4159

Provides that the Governor shall appoint one member of the Oregon Government Ethics Commission who has local government experience.

HB 4161

Provides exceptions to the prohibited use by a public official of official position or office to obtain financial gain or avoid financial detriment that permit a public body to give public officials food, beverages and merchandise.

HB 4177

Restates the serial communications prohibitions for public meetings law purposes.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 4091

Allows the Adjutant General to facilitate, assist or coordinate in the mobilization of the Oregon National Guard under Title 10 of the United States Code or Title 32 of the United States Code under an authority other than the Governor, only if the active service is for certain listed reasons.

Work Session

Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

HB 4002

Limits to 25 the number of legislative measures that a member of the Legislative Assembly may ask the Legislative Counsel to prepare for a regular session of the Legislative Assembly that begins in an odd-numbered year.

HB 4018

Requires the Secretary of State to study elections.

HB 4021

Requires certain agencies to make adoption, amendment or repeal of administrative rules effective only on January 1, April 1, July 1 or October 1.
