**Public Hearing and Work Session**

SB 1547

Authorizes the Oregon Board of Psychology to issue a license to practice behavioral health promotion, prevention and brief intervention to a qualified applicant.

**Public Hearing**

SB 1546

Requires operators of artificial intelligence companions and artificial intelligence platforms to provide notice to users that the users are interacting with artificial output.

SB 1573

Prohibits a syringe service program from operating a mobile or temporary location within 2,000 feet of a school or licensed child care facility.
