SB 1535

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/10/2026 MEETING:

Please note: this public hearing of SB 1568 is scheduled solely for the purpose of hearing testimony from the people who previously signed up to testify at the meeting on 2/10/2026.
Requires the Department of Early Learning and Care to study child care.

Work Session

SB 1546

Requires operators of artificial intelligence companions and artificial intelligence platforms to provide notice to users that the users are interacting with artificial output.

SB 1548

Requires cannabinoid edibles to be individually packaged and allows up to 10 milligrams of adult use cannabinoid per individual cannabinoid edible.

SB 1573

Prohibits a syringe service program from operating a mobile or temporary location within 2,000 feet of a school or licensed child care facility.

SB 1568

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/10/2026 MEETING:

Establishes minimum coverage levels for doula services in the state medical assistance program and for health benefit plans that reimburse the costs of pregnancy and childbirth expenses.
