#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 4037 A

Adjusts certain terms of the revolving loan program for cities and counties to fund affordable housing projects.

HB 4108 A

Allows the City of Eugene to annex noncontiguous land upon receipt of a petition from all owners of the land that satisfies four eligibility criteria.

HB 4120 A

Allows residential landlords of multifamily housing to convert premises to nonsmoking for existing tenants upon 180 days' written notice.
