#### Public Hearing

SB 1515

Modifies provisions relating to petitions for compensation for wrongful conviction.

SB 1517

Modifies provisions relating to liability related to skiing

SB 1550

Directs law enforcement, prior to making any findings as to the cause or manner of death where the decedent is suspected to have died from suicide, overdose or accident, to interview family members of the decedent if the decedent has a history as a victim of domestic violence or child abuse and certain conditions exist.

SB 1556

Consolidates statutes governing the representation of parties before the magistrate division of the Oregon Tax Court.

SB 1557

Modifies provisions relating to contempt proceedings.

SB 1563

Allows a person who has been deprived of rights, privileges or immunities secured by the Oregon Constitution or the laws of this state by a person acting under color of law to bring a civil action for economic and noneconomic damages and for injunctive or other equitable relief.

SB 1583

Establishes the Behavioral Health and Deflection Committee within the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission

SB 1594

Directs the Office of Immigrant and Refugee Advancement to develop and maintain model policies, standards and procedures related to the enforcement of federal immigration laws.
