**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

The measure authorizes the Oregon Ocean Science Trust to create and maintain a non-profit organization under section 501(c) 3 for the purpose of advancing the trust's mission.

**BACKGROUND:**

In 2009, [House Bill 3106](#) created the Oregon Task Force on Nearshore Research (Task Force) to recommend long-term funding and coordination strategies for implementing the nearshore priorities of the state including research and monitoring; management and policy formation; and education and outreach. The Task Force recommended creating a trust to provide a funding mechanism to support the implementation of the Nearshore Strategic Plan and identified research and monitoring needs. As a result, the Oregon Ocean Science Trust was created by the Legislature in 2013 through the passage of [Senate Bill 737](#) to promote ocean and coastal resource research and monitoring.
