LC 39 clarifies the meaning of “companionship services” for the purpose of minimum wage and overtime requirements for certain individuals performing such services.

LC 119 requires the governor to appoint one member of the Oregon Government Ethics Commission (OGE) who has local government experience. It also maintains the attorney-client privilege for a information provided to OGE regarding a complaint alleging a violation of government ethics or public meetings laws.

LC 125 directs schools to have a cardiac emergency response plan as part of the procedures for responding to medical emergencies. It prescribes the requirements of a cardiac emergency response plan, including requirements related to automated external defibrillators.

LC 158 is placeholder relating to automatic voter registration.

LC 159 is placeholder relating to campaign finance.

LC 160 is placeholder relating to campaign finance.

LC 163 is placeholder relating to community safety.

LC 164 is placeholder relating to environmental regulations.

LC 167 is placeholder relating to food assistance.

LC 169 is placeholder relating to health care.

LC 170 is placeholder relating to housing.

LC 171 is placeholder relating to immigration.

LC 173 is placeholder relating to government ethics.

LC 176 is placeholder relating to public meetings.

LC 177 is placeholder relating to public records.

LC 224 provides an exception to the ethics laws to allow a public body to provide public officials food and beverages during meetings, other official events, or when required by state law or rules, and merchandise if the cost does not exceed \$100 in a calendar year, or as provided by the public body's policies.

LC 311 is placeholder relating to transportation.

LC 312 is placeholder relating to health care.

LC 315 repeals Ballot Measure 119 (2024) that requires certain licensees of the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission to enter into labor peace agreements with bona fide labor organizations representing the licensees' employees.
