WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

States that a peace officer may not be held criminally or civilly liable for the use of restraints on or physical force against a person in the course of the peace officer's transportation of the person under civil commitment laws. For the immunity to apply, requires that the officer reasonably believes the restraints or physical force are necessary to protect the person, the officer or the public and the officer uses the restraints or physical force in good faith and without malice. Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.
