Bill Title: Relating to cannabis; prescribing an effective date; providing for revenue raising that requires approval by a three-fifths majority.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Cities, Counties, Criminal Justice Commission, Department of Agriculture, Department of State Police, Judicial Department, Oregon Health Authority, Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission

Summary of Fiscal Impact:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Economic Development, Small Business, and Trade to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure requires the Department of Revenue to make quarterly transfers from the Oregon Marijuana Account and increases the transfer to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission for deposit into the Illegal Marijuana Market Enforcement Grant Program Fund from \$750,000 to \$3 million. The measure also modifies the definition of “debilitating medical condition” to allow an attending provider to determine qualifying conditions for medical marijuana use based on evidence-based practice and professional judgment.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the next committee.
