Bill Title: Relating to infertility; declaring an emergency.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Oregon Health Authority, Department of Consumer and Business Services

Summary of Fiscal Impact:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Health Care to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure requires the Oregon Health Authority to study fertility and reproductive endocrinology services and report to the Legislature by September 15, 2027. Initial analysis estimates costs for this study will be \$566,249 General Fund. Additionally, the measure requires health benefit plans to reimburse the cost of procedures and medication medically necessary to address infertility. The biennial cost of this provision on the Public Employees Benefit Board and the Oregon Educator's Benefit Board is estimated to be \$29.5 million Other Funds.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the next committee.
