Bill Title: Relating to energy; prescribing an effective date.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Public Utility Commission

Summary of Fiscal Impact:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Energy and Environment to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure requires each electric company to develop and file with the Public Utility Commission (PUC) a distributed power plant program to procure grid services from customers who enroll distributed energy resources, including battery storage, load control devices, solar systems and electric vehicles. The PUC must approve or modify proposed programs, establish annual procurement targets and performance incentives, adopt standards for third-party aggregators and require annual reporting on program performance. Electric companies must file an initial program by July 1, 2027, and later expand it to include additional distributed energy resource technologies.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the next committee.
