SUMMARY

Digest: The Act makes a commission on AI to be a central resource on using AI in this state. The Act also tells DAS to hire a Chief Artificial Intelligence Officer. (Flesch Readability Score: 67.5).

Establishes the Senator Aaron Woods Commission on Artificial Intelligence within the office of Enterprise Information Services. Establishes the commission's purpose to serve as a central resource to monitor the use of artificial intelligence technologies and systems in this state and report on long-term policy implications. Directs the commission to provide an annual report to the Legislative Assembly. Allows the commission to make recommendations for legislation, regulations or policy to the Legislative Assembly.

Directs the Oregon Department of Administrative Services to hire a Chief Artificial Intelligence Officer to assist the commission in carrying out the commission's duties. Allows the department to charge a state or local agency or public body for the commission's services.
