WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

The measure requires state and local law enforcement agencies to cooperate with federal law enforcement in carrying out actions concerning people who have been convicted of a crime constituting a class A misdemeanor or felony under Oregon law, notwithstanding any other provision of Oregon law.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Interaction with Oregon’s sanctuary law
- Limitation of cooperation with the federal government to felonies and class A misdemeanors
- Messaging to the federal government

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

The amendment replaces the measure.

BACKGROUND:

Under ORS 190.110, local or state agencies in Oregon may, by agreement or otherwise, cooperate with federal agencies for any lawful purpose. When Oregon agencies enter into agreements for this kind of cooperation, they must submit a summary of the agreement to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services under ORS 190.115. Some laws restrict when public bodies in Oregon may cooperate with the federal government. For example, Oregon sanctuary laws prohibit Oregon law enforcement and public agencies from collecting certain information and from cooperating with the federal government on immigration matters, with limited exceptions (see ORS 180.805, 181A.820–181A.829).
