#### WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

The measure requires the Oregon Department of Energy (ODOE) to evaluate and prioritize geographically dispersed emergency fuel sites.

#### Detailed Summary:

Describes considerations for site analysis. Requires ODOE to submit a preliminary report to the legislature's interim committees related to energy and emergency management by June 15, 2027, and requires a final report by September 15, 2028. Repeals the measure on January 2, 2029. Adds a \$250,000 appropriation to ODOE to carry out Section 1 of the measure.

#### ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Cascadia Subduction Zone event and its possible impacts
- Provisions of the measure

#### EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

The amendment adds a \$250,000 appropriation to ODOE to carry out Section 1 of the measure.

#### BACKGROUND:

Senate Bill 1567 (2022) required ODOE to develop the Oregon Energy Security Plan to evaluate the state's ability to recover quickly from physical threats, including a potential 9.0-magnitude Cascadia Subduction Zone earthquake, and cybersecurity threats. The measure also required the department to make recommendations for increasing the geographic diversity of fuel storage capacity throughout the state.
