**Measure Description:**

Transfers funds from the State Information Technology Operating Fund and the Oregon Infrastructure Finance Fund to the General Fund. Removes the allocation limit on the net lottery proceeds to the County Fair Account, effective July 1, 2027. Beginning with the 2027-29 biennium, the allocation to the account is one percent of the net lottery proceeds. Redistributes \$218 million from various sources to ODOT’s Operation and Maintenance (O&M) functions. Some of these funds come from within the ODOT’s share of the Highway Fund (\$143 million), otherwise directed to different projects. Other funds come from non-highway funds that are dedicated, but not constitutionally restricted, and would be otherwise used in the connect Oregon and Multimodal programs (\$50 million), Transportation Operation Fund (\$20 million), and the Student Driver Training Fund (\$5 million).
