**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4092**

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “systems” delete the rest of the
- 2 line and add a period.
- 3 In line 6, delete “who weighs 80 pounds or less”.
- 4 In line 10, after “the” delete the rest of the line and line 11 and insert
- 5 “effective date of this 2026 Act.”.
- 6 Delete lines 21 and 22 and insert:
 - 7 “(B) ‘Retail platform operator’ does not include:
 - 8 “(i) A financial institution, as defined in ORS 706.008, a payment
 - 9 processor or payment clearance system operator; or
 - 10 “(ii) A person that delivers a child safety system to a purchaser on behalf
 - 11 of another person but that does not advertise, offer for sale or sell the child
 - 12 safety system to the purchaser.”.
- 13 On page 2, line 1, after “not” insert “knowingly”.
- 14 In line 2, after “not” insert “knowingly”.
- 15 Delete lines 5 through 10.
- 16 In line 11, delete “(4)” and insert “(3)”.
- 17 Delete lines 17 through 45 and delete pages 3 through 5 and insert:
 - 18 “(4) A person that violates subsection (2) or (3) of this section shall, upon
 - 19 a written demand from a purchaser, cure the violation within 30 days after
 - 20 receiving the purchaser’s demand.
- 21 “(5) A purchaser who delivers a written demand under subsection (4) of

1 this section may bring an action in a court of this state against a person that
2 fails to cure within 30 days after the date of the purchaser's demand a vio-
3 lation of subsection (2) or (3) of this section. The purchaser may obtain in
4 the action:

5 “(a) The greater of the purchaser's actual damages or statutory damages
6 of \$500; and

7 “(b) Such other equitable relief as the court may specify.”.
