**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4055**

- 1 On page 2 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 24 and insert:
 - 2 "(2) A public body shall, within 48 hours of discovering an information
 - 3 security incident or ransomware incident, notify the State Chief Information
 - 4 Officer of the incident. A public body may include in the notification infor-
 - 5 mation on any assistance the public body may need:
 - 6 "(a) To prevent or mitigate further impacts from the incident; or
 - 7 "(b) To respond to or recover from the incident.".
- 8 In line 25, delete "(4)" and insert "(3)" and delete "report" and insert "notification".
- 9 In line 29, delete "report" and insert "notification".
- 10 After line 32, insert:
 - 11 "(B) The Oregon Department of Emergency Management;".
 - 12 In line 33, delete "(B)" and insert "(C)".
 - 13 In line 34, delete "(C)" and insert "(D)".
 - 14 In line 38, delete "(5)" and insert "(4)".
 - 15 In line 39, delete "and submit a report".
 - 16 In line 41, delete "that" and insert "for which".
 - 17 In line 42, delete "report" and insert "provide notification".
 - 18 On page 3, line 3, delete "and reports".
 - 19 In line 8, delete "that were reported" and insert "for which the State
 - 20 Chief Information Officer received notifications".

1 Delete lines 19 through 23 and insert:

2 “(3) No later than 90 days after the effective date of this 2026 Act, the
3 State Chief Information Officer shall create and maintain the webpage de-
4 scribed under section 1 (4) of this 2026 Act.”
