**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4007**

9 **“KEI TRUCKS**

11 **“SECTION 29. Section 30 of this 2026 Act is added to and made a**
12 **part of the Oregon Vehicle Code.**

13 **“SECTION 30. ‘Kei truck’ means a motor vehicle that:**

14 **“(1) Was originally manufactured in Japan or South Korea;**

15 **“(2) Has an engine that has a piston or rotor displacement of 660**
16 **cubic centimeters;**

17 **“(3) Is 11 feet or less in length;**

18 **“(4) Is 4.9 feet or less in width;**

19 **“(5) Is 6.6 feet or less in height; and**

20 **“(6) Has a model year that predates the current year by 25 years**
21 **or more.**

1 **“SECTION 31.** ORS 803.045 is amended to read:

2 “803.045. (1) The Department of Transportation shall issue title for a ve-
3 hicle if the applicant and the vehicle meet the following qualifications:

4 “(a) The applicant must satisfy the department that the applicant is the
5 owner of the vehicle and is otherwise entitled to have title issued in the
6 applicant’s name.

7 “(b) Except as otherwise provided in ORS 803.050 (2), the applicant must
8 submit a completed and signed application for title described in ORS 803.050.

9 “(c) The applicant must pay the fee for issuance of a certificate of title
10 under ORS 803.090 or the fee for issuance of title in another form, as estab-
11 lished by the department by rule in accordance with ORS 803.012.

12 “(d) If the vehicle is a reconstructed vehicle or an assembled vehicle, the
13 applicant must provide the following information in addition to any other
14 information required under this section:

15 “(A) The certificate of title last issued for the frame of the vehicle, a
16 salvage title certificate issued for the vehicle or other evidence of ownership
17 satisfactory to the department.

18 “(B) Bills of sale for major components used to build the vehicle.

19 “(e) If the vehicle is covered by an Oregon title or salvage title certif-
20 icate, the applicant shall surrender the Oregon title or salvage title certif-
21 icate, submit an application as provided under ORS 803.065 or submit other
22 evidence of ownership satisfactory to the department.

23 “(f) Unless the department adopts rules to the contrary, if the vehicle is
24 from another jurisdiction, the applicant shall surrender to the department
25 with the application the certificate of title issued by the other jurisdiction,
26 if such jurisdiction requires certificates of title. If such jurisdiction does not
27 require certificates of title, then the applicant shall surrender the registra-
28 tion cards.

29 “(g) If required by the department, the applicant must submit proof of
30 ownership as described under ORS 803.205.

1 “(h) Other than a racing activity vehicle [*as defined in ORS 801.404*] **or**
2 **Kei truck**, if the department has reason to believe a vehicle was not certi-
3 fied by the original manufacturer as conforming to federal vehicle standards,
4 the department may require the applicant to provide proof satisfactory to the
5 department that the vehicle conforms to federal vehicle standards.

6 “(i) Unless the vehicle is exempted from odometer disclosure require-
7 ments, the applicant shall submit an appropriate odometer disclosure form.
8 The department shall determine what constitutes an appropriate form in any
9 particular situation. The department may make exceptions by rule to the
10 requirement for submission of an odometer disclosure form.

11 “(2) The department may not issue title for a vehicle:

12 “(a) Required by ORS 803.210 to be inspected unless the vehicle has been
13 inspected as described in ORS 803.212 and the inspection fee paid under ORS
14 803.215.

15 “(b) If the current vehicle title, certificate, ownership document or the
16 vehicle record available through electronic record inquiry:

17 “(A) Has a junk status;

18 “(B) Is a junk title, junk certificate or similar ownership document issued
19 by another jurisdiction; or

20 “(C) Has a junk or similar brand or notation.

21 “(c) As prescribed in ORS 803.591.

22 “(3) The department may adopt any rules it considers necessary for the
23 administration of subsection (2)(a) and (b) of this section.

24 “**SECTION 32.** ORS 803.210 is amended to read:

25 “803.210. (1) The Department of Transportation shall not issue title for a
26 vehicle described in subsection (2) of this section unless:

27 “(a) An inspection of the vehicle identification number or numbers of the
28 vehicle is performed in accordance with ORS 803.212; and

29 “(b) The fee established under ORS 803.215 is paid to the department for
30 the inspection.

1 “(2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, the requirements
2 of this section apply to all of the following:

3 “(a) A vehicle from another jurisdiction.

4 “(b) Any assembled or reconstructed vehicle.

5 “(c) Any vehicle if the certificate of title has been or is required to be
6 submitted to the department, or a person is required to report to the de-
7 partment, under ORS 819.010, 819.012, 819.014 or 819.030.

8 “(d) Any vehicle if the department has received notice that the vehicle
9 has been or will be wrecked, dismantled or disassembled under ORS 819.010
10 or 822.135.

11 “(e) Replicas.

12 “(f) Other than a racing activity vehicle [*as defined in ORS 801.404*] **or**
13 **Kei truck**, any vehicle the department has reason to believe was not certi-
14 fied by the original manufacturer as conforming to federal vehicle standards.

15 “(3) The requirements of this section do not apply to the following vehi-
16 cles if the person shown as the owner on an out-of-state title for the vehicle
17 applies for an Oregon title in that person’s name:

18 “(a) A rental truck, rental truck tractor or rental trailer that is registered
19 in Oregon under an interstate agreement that provides that a portion of the
20 owner’s fleet is to be registered in each state in which the fleet operates.

21 “(b) A trailer or semitrailer that has permanent registration.

22 “(4) The requirement to inspect a vehicle identification number or num-
23 bers of the vehicle under subsection (1) of this section does not apply to park
24 model recreational vehicles, as defined in ORS 803.036, or former park model
25 recreational vehicles.

26 “**SECTION 33.** ORS 803.420, as amended by section 18 (6)(e), chapter 1,
27 Oregon Laws 2025 (special session), is amended to read:

28 “803.420. (1) The vehicle registration fees imposed under this section shall
29 be based on the classifications determined by the Department of Transpor-
30 tation by rule. The department may classify a vehicle to ensure that regis-

1 tration fees for the vehicle are the same as for other vehicles the department
2 determines to be comparable.

3 “(2) Except as otherwise provided in this section, or unless the vehicle is
4 registered quarterly, the fees described in this section are for an entire reg-
5 istration period for the vehicle as described under ORS 803.415. For a vehicle
6 registered for a quarterly registration period under ORS 803.415, the depart-
7 ment shall apportion any fee under this section to reflect the number of
8 quarters registered.

9 “(3) Vehicle registration fees are due when a vehicle is registered and
10 when the registered owner renews the registration.

11 “(4) In addition to the registration fees listed in this section, a county
12 or a district may impose an additional registration fee as provided under
13 ORS 801.041 and 801.042.

14 “(5) A rental or leasing company, as defined in ORS 221.275, that elects
15 to initially register a vehicle for an annual or biennial registration period
16 shall pay a fee of \$2 in addition to the vehicle registration fee provided under
17 this section.

18 “(6) The registration fees for each year of the registration period for ve-
19 hicles subject to biennial registration are as follows:

20 “(a) Passenger vehicles not otherwise provided for in this section or ORS
21 821.320, \$43.

22 “(b) Utility trailers or light trailers, as those terms are defined by rule
23 by the department, \$63.

24 “(c) Mopeds and motorcycles, \$44.

25 “(d) Low-speed vehicles, \$63.

26 “(e) Medium-speed electric vehicles, \$105.

27 “(f) **Kei trucks, \$63.**

28 “(7) The registration fees for vehicles that are subject to biennial regis-
29 tration and that are listed in this subsection are as follows:

30 “(a) State-owned vehicles registered under ORS 805.045 and undercover

1 vehicles registered under ORS 805.060, \$10 upon registration or renewal.

2 “(b) Fixed load vehicles:

3 “(A) If a declaration of weight described under ORS 803.435 is submitted
4 establishing the weight of the vehicle at 3,000 pounds or less, \$61.

5 “(B) If no declaration of weight is submitted or if the weight of the ve-
6 hicles is in excess of 3,000 pounds, \$82.

7 “(c) Travel trailers, special use trailers, campers and motor homes, based
8 on length as determined under ORS 803.425:

9 “(A) Trailers or campers that are 6 to 10 feet in length, \$81.

10 “(B) Trailers or campers over 10 feet in length, \$81 plus \$7 a foot for each
11 foot of length over the first 10 feet.

12 “(C) Motor homes that are 6 to 14 feet in length, \$86.

13 “(D) Motor homes over 14 feet in length, \$126 plus \$8 a foot for each foot
14 of length over the first 10 feet.

15 “(8) The registration fee for trailers for hire that are equipped with
16 pneumatic tires made of an elastic material and that are not travel trailers
17 or trailers registered under permanent registration is \$30.

18 “(9) The registration fees for vehicles subject to ownership registration
19 are as follows:

20 “(a) Government-owned vehicles registered under ORS 805.040, \$5.

21 “(b) Vehicles registered with special registration for disabled veterans
22 under ORS 805.100 or for former prisoners of war under ORS 805.110, \$15.

23 “(c) School vehicles registered under ORS 805.050, \$5.

24 “(10) The registration fees for vehicles subject to permanent registration
25 are as follows:

26 “(a) Antique vehicles registered under ORS 805.010, \$100.

27 “(b) Vehicles of special interest registered under ORS 805.020, \$100.

28 “(c) Racing activity vehicles registered under ORS 805.035, \$100.

29 “(d) Trailers, \$10.

30 “(e) State-owned vehicles registered under ORS 805.045 and undercover

vehicles registered under ORS 805.060, \$10.

“(11) The registration fee for trailers registered as part of a fleet under an agreement reached pursuant to ORS 802.500 is the same fee as the fee for vehicles of the same type registered under other provisions of the Oregon Vehicle Code.

“(12) The registration fee for vehicles with proportional registration under ORS 826.009, or proportional fleet registration under ORS 826.011, is the same fee as the fee for vehicles of the same type under this section except that the fees shall be fixed on an apportioned basis as provided under the agreement established under ORS 826.007.

“(13) In addition to any other registration fees charged for registration of vehicles in fleets under ORS 805.120, the department may charge the following fees:

“(a) Service charge for each vehicle entered into a fleet, \$3.

“(b) Service charge for each vehicle in the fleet at the time of renewal, \$2.

“(14)(a) The registration fee for motor vehicles required to establish a registration weight under ORS 803.430 or 826.013, tow vehicles used to transport property for hire other than as described in ORS 822.210 and commercial buses is as provided in the following chart, based upon the weight submitted in the declaration of weight prepared under ORS 803.435 or 826.015:

10 paragraph must certify at the time of initial registration, in a manner de-
11 termined by the department by rule, that the motor vehicle will be used ex-
12 clusively to transport manufactured structures or exclusively as described in
13 ORS 822.210, unless the motor vehicle is registered under paragraph (a) of
14 this subsection, or as described in ORS 825.015 or 825.017 (13). Registration
15 of a vehicle described in subparagraph (A) or (B) of this paragraph is invalid
16 if the vehicle is operated in any manner other than that described in the
17 certification under this subparagraph.

 17 an additional fee of \$2.

 20 803.430 or 826.013 are as follows:

21 “(a) State-owned vehicles registered under ORS 805.045, \$10.

“(12) The registration fee for vehicles with proportional registration under ORS 826.009, or proportional fleet registration under ORS 826.011, is the same fee as the fee for vehicles of the same type under this section except that the fees shall be fixed on an apportioned basis as provided under the agreement established under ORS 826.007.

“(13) In addition to any other registration fees charged for registration of vehicles in fleets under ORS 805.120, the department may charge the following fees:

“(a) Service charge for each vehicle entered into a fleet, \$3.

“(b) Service charge for each vehicle in the fleet at the time of renewal, \$2.

“(14)(a) The registration fee for motor vehicles required to establish a registration weight under ORS 803.430 or 826.013, tow vehicles used to transport property for hire other than as described in ORS 822.210 and commercial buses is as provided in the following chart, based upon the weight submitted in the declaration of weight prepared under ORS 803.435 or 826.015:

2 “(3) The department may review specifications adopted by ASTM Inter-
3 national, or equivalent organizations, and federal regulations and revise the
4 standards adopted under this section as necessary.

5 “(4) A wholesale dealer, retail dealer or nonretail dealer may sell or offer
6 for sale gasoline that is not blended with ethanol if the gasoline has an
7 octane rating, as defined in ORS 646.945, of 91 or above or if the gasoline is
8 for use in:

9 “(a) An aircraft:

10 “(A) With a supplemental type certificate approved by the Federal Avi-
11 ation Administration that allows the aircraft to use gasoline that is intended
12 for use in motor vehicles; or

13 “(B) Issued a type certificate by an aircraft engine manufacturer that al-
14 lows the aircraft to use gasoline that is intended for use in motor vehicles;

15 “(b) An aircraft that has been issued an experimental certificate, as de-
16 scribed in 14 C.F.R. 21.191, by the Federal Aviation Administration and for
17 which the manufacturer’s specifications require the use of gasoline that is
18 intended for use in motor vehicles;

19 “(c) A light-sport aircraft, as defined in 14 C.F.R. 1.1, for which the
20 manufacturer’s specifications require the use of gasoline that is intended for
