**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4147**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “creating new provisions;
2 amending ORS 657.665;”.

3 In line 5, delete “5” and insert “4”.

4 In line 14, delete “50” and insert “500”.

5 Delete lines 15 through 17 and insert:

6 “(b) ‘Employer’ does not mean a tribal government.”.

7 After line 23, insert:

8 “(8) ‘Tribal government’ means:

9 “(a) A tribal government as defined in ORS 181A.940; or

10 “(b) A federally recognized Indian tribe.”.

11 Delete lines 24 and 25 and on page 2, delete lines 1 through 36 and insert:

12 **“SECTION 2. (1) Not later than January 15 of each year, the Oregon**
13 **Health Authority, in collaboration with the Department of Human**
14 **Services and the Employment Department, shall submit a report to**
15 **the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health**
16 **care, in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and to the Legislative**
17 **Fiscal Officer, that includes the following information for the preced-**
18 **ing state fiscal year:**

19 **“(a) For each employer in this state that has employees who are**
20 **medical assistance recipients:**

21 **“(A) The name of the employer;**

1 “(B) A description of the industry in which the employer does
2 business in this state, using the North American Industry Classifica-
3 tion System code associated with the employer;

4 “(C) The total number of medical assistance recipients who are an
5 employee of the employer;

6 “(D) The total number of medical assistance recipients who are a
7 dependent of an employee of the employer, if the employee is a medical
8 assistance recipient; and

9 “(E) The cost of providing medical assistance to the employees or
10 dependents.

11 “(b) Aggregated statewide information regarding:

12 “(A) The total number of medical assistance recipients who are an
13 employee or a dependent of an employee who is a medical assistance
14 recipient;

15 “(B) The total number of medical assistance recipients who are an
16 employee or a dependent of an employee who is a medical assistance
17 recipient, distributed by:

18 “(i) Employer size;

19 “(ii) Industry; and

20 “(iii) Region; and

21 “(C) The demographics of medical assistance recipients who are an
22 employee or a dependent of an employee who is a medical assistance
23 recipient.

24 “(c) A summary of the 20 employers with the highest total number
25 of medical assistance recipients who are an employee of the employer
26 or a dependent of an employee who is a medical assistance recipient.

27 “(d) For state fiscal years beginning on or after July 1, 2028, anal-
28 ysis of trends related to the number of medical assistance recipients
29 who are an employee or a dependent of an employee who is a medical
30 assistance recipient, as compared to earlier years.

1 “(2) A report required under this section may not include any per-
2 sonally identifiable information or protected health information of an
3 employee or dependent whose information is included in the report.

4 “(3) The collection, storage and release of health care data and
5 other information under sections 1 to 4 of this 2026 Act is subject to
6 the privacy regulations of the federal Health Insurance Portability and
7 Accountability Act.”.

8 In line 42, delete “5” and insert “4”.

9 On page 3, delete lines 6 through 45 and delete pages 4 through 7.

10 On page 8, delete lines 1 through 40 and insert:

11 “SECTION 5. The Oregon Health Authority, the Department of
12 Human Services and the Employment Department may adopt rules
13 necessary to carry out the provisions of sections 1 to 4 of this 2026 Act.

14 “SECTION 6. (1) Sections 1 to 5 of this 2026 Act become operative
15 on January 1, 2027.

16 “(2) The Oregon Health Authority, the Department of Human Ser-
17 vices and the Employment Department may take any action before the
18 operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is neces-
19 sary to enable the authority and the departments to exercise, on and
20 after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all
21 of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the authority and the
22 departments by sections 1 to 5 of this 2026 Act.”.
