



HB 4096: *Aggravated Felon in Possession of Firearm*

ORCOPS Supports

HB 4096 (Rep Ruiz) creates a new Class B Felony for persons convicted of a felony who possess three or more firearms or who have one or more prior convictions for felon in possession of a firearm.

ORCOPS has reviewed the legislation, supports it, and encourages its passage.

The bill has no negative impact on law-abiding gun owners – there are no new prohibitions on firearm ownership.

However, law enforcement supports the bill as our officers do face dangerous situations in which felons – who are legally barred from owning firearms – often possess multiple firearms. These individuals can be volatile, violent, and pose serious dangers to law enforcement and the public.
