SB1545

I urge you to pass SB1545 in order to make it clear that 'corner crossing' is legal in the State of Oregon.

When we walk from our property onto BLM acreage open to the public, we quickly come to a corner where private lands touch and the BLM parcels touch. Indeed, the public lands near our home have a lot of this 'checkerboard' ownership pattern, creating the opportunity/need to make numerous corner crossings in order to use our public land. These lands are locked away from public use when people feel they cannot cross from public land corner to public land corner. This activity should be clearly designated as appropriate use, which SB1545 accomplishes.
