I urge you to oppose HB 4006. Oregon's water belongs to the public. Exempting irrigators in one area of the state from important water laws that every other farmer in Oregon must adhere to is not good for the Columbia River, the Umatilla Basin, or our state.

I have a law degree and I have worked around Oregon water law for a long time, and this bill undermines core principles of Oregon water law, sets a dangerous precedent, and undermines Oregon Water Resources Department's ability to manage over 700,000 acres of irrigated agriculture.

I am also concerned about the effect of increased agriculture on the groundwater quality of the Lower Umatilla Basin Ground Water Management Area, as increased irrigation risks increased nitrate inputs into groundwater.

Please oppose this bill.
