I oppose House Bill 4105, which would weaken protections for Oregon's state forests, require the Department of Forestry to pass a timber harvest rule that would prioritize clearcut timber harvest at the expense of all other values—values like clean water, fish and wildlife, recreation, and carbon absorption and storage, and create a special right for recipients of timber revenue to sue the Department of Forestry to force more logging on state forests.
