She kept yelling that her green card was in her pocket, but not until her daughter drove up and demanded that they look at her green card, did they release her. There have been other multiple attacks by ICE, all of which has the whole immigrant community in a total state of panic. They are not going to work and school. I hardly see them at the store. Our local police, despite Oregon laws, and because of federal laws, are unable to act to protect local citizens.

This is pure terrorism.

Outlawing face masks would be a good first step. The ICE men could be identified and charged at some time, and perhaps be more susceptible to listening to their consciences.
