



The Oregon Psychological Association supports SB 1548.

This measure aims to enhance the safety and well-being of Oregon's children and young adults by implementing changes to the packaging and potency limits of THC edibles.

Recent research points to dose-dependent risks associated with THC, particularly concerning serious mental health issues such as depression, anxiety, suicidal thoughts, and psychosis among youth and young adults. The high-potency cannabis products available today significantly contribute to these risks. SB 1548 addresses this concern by limiting cannabis edibles to single-serving units of 10mg THC, with requirements for individual wrapping even within multi-serving containers.

The bill not only safeguards young children but also contributes to the mental health and safety of adolescents and adults. By reducing the potency of edibles, SB 1548 aims to diminish associated adverse mental health outcomes.
